The Lord God of All possibilities - DAY 5

Topic: Living a life of possibilities

Mark 10:27 NIV Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God."

We serve a God of all possibilities.

Do not give up on God and you shall see your prayers answered.

We must follow those whom through faith and patience inherit the promise according to Hebrews 6:12.

Just keep praying concerning that issue of your life, keep believing God for an instant turnaround encounter and God will show up in that situation.

I believe that as you pray tonight for impossible situations, the God of all possibilities will visit you today in Jesus name.

Possibility give birth to new realities; it paves way for great innovations and giant strides in Kingdom pursuits.

Are you living in the realm of Possibilities? Or are you part of the crowd in the dark of impossibilities?

To achieve your goals and accomplish your God-given projects in life, you need to step out of the crowd!

1. You need to start thinking 'It is Possible!'

To live a life of possibility, it starts with Possibility Thinking.

The Bible says in Proverbs 23:7, 'For as he thinks in his heart, so is he'.

Spend time having great thoughts about God and great thoughts about the things God can do through you.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Paul told us in Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

The things we meditate on may build or negatively affect our lives.

If you think it is not possible, then it will not be possible. Think great and noble thoughts; welcome fresh ideas and open your mind to new and good things.

It all begins with your thoughts!

2. Possibility Speaking.

Possibility Speaking is speaking positive things. Start by preaching to yourself anytime you are tempted to speak negative things.

Learn to speak positive things about your family, friends, future and whatsoever you find your hands doing.

The Bible says, in Psalm 107:2 Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy.

Jesus Himself said in Mark 11:23-24 "For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says"

Our words are seeds that will bring good or evil fruits.

If we speak positively, we will reap abundant positive fruits.

3. Possibility Prayers.

Possibility prayer is one that affirms God's greatness, a prayer that talks of the goodness of God.

It is confident prayer; a prayer that is not beggarly but full of boldness.

Pray with authority and confidence.

Declare the promises of God for your life. David said, "I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust" (Psalm 91:2).

Jesus told the Father, "...I know that You always hear Me..." (John 11:42 NKJV).

He taught us that "everyone who asks receives, and he who Seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened" (Matthew 7:8-9).

4. Possibility Living is when we take Positive Steps of Faith and do what God has called us to do.

The journey of a thousand miles begins with the first step.

It is your acts that produce results, not your intentions. Today is the day of salvation, not tomorrow.

So begin now to obey God, to act diligently, to work purposefully and to give yourself entirely to the work God has called you to perform.

Never forget, it is God that works in you 'to do' but you must 'work out your salvation.' Align your goals with the purpose of God for your life, pray through them; act them as soon as possible, and go out in praises. '...For with God all things are possible!'
