The Lord God of All possibilities - DAY 1

Before we can have better understanding of possibility, we need to know what impossibility is.

The dictionary defines impossible as "incapable of being done, attained, or fulfilled.

Possibility is a chance that something will happen or be true:

It's not likely to happen but that it would happen.

Only God, the creator of the heaven and the earth has the capacity to make impossible possible.

Text: Matthew 19:26, But Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

When we fail at something, especially if we try that thing more than once, we can quickly lose confidence.

Things that appear easy and extremely possible for others can be challenging and seem impossible for us.

Completing certain tasks may be beyond the bounds of possibility for us, certain things may be unattainable, at this point, note that we are not working towards them alone.

God is always with us and He makes the impossible possible every day.

For the impossible to be made possible we need to fully trust in God.

In order to do this we need to cast any doubts aside, no matter how reasonable they appear to be.

We also need to show recognition that we cannot do it alone by appealing to Him for His help.

Making the impossible possible isn't the same as granting every desire.

Just because something we want to happen doesn't happen, this doesn't mean that God is powerless.

It is because not every aim we have is compatible with God's plan for us.

We have every reason to be courageous and optimistic.

God has proven His power in the past – the Bible gives us many examples of Him doing so – but He also proves it in our present.

God's word is a great confidence booster during times when we have to face the unfeasable.

As well as finding examples of God's greatness, we can also rediscover accounts of His ability to do what would ordinarily be unachievable.

Let us look at some Bible verses which boldly show that our God is God of all possibilities.

Matthew 19:26 - Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

Luke 1:36-37 - And behold, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. For nothing will be impossible with God.

Prayer: God of all possibilities, you put an end to barrenness in the life of Elizabeth put an end to barrenness (mention your barrenness) in my life.

Jeremiah 32:17 - 'Ah, Lord God! It is you who have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for you.

Prayer: O Lord of possibility, nothing is too hard for you, my own must not be too hard for you to do today, this week, this month and this year in Jesus name.

Mark 9:20-23 - So they brought him. When the spirit saw Jesus, it immediately threw the boy into a convulsion. He fell to the ground and rolled around, foaming at the mouth. Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?"

It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. But if you can do anything, take pity on us and help us."

If you can'?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for one who believes."

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I believed, tonight throw the problems of my life into convulsion and let it rush out of my life with trembling in the name of Jesus.

Job 42:2 - "I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted."

Prayer: The Lord God who can do all things, your purpose for my life will not be thwarted by the enemies in Jesus name.

Genesis 18:13-14 - Then the Lord said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh and say, 'Will I really have a child, now that I am old?' Is anything too hard for the Lord? I will return to you at the appointed time next year, and Sarah will have a son."

Prayer: Oh God of all possibilities, Sarah laughed because she had lost hope but you made her laughed in deed by giving her Isaac, give me my heart desire to laugh in deed this year.

Ephesians 3:20 - Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.
