My wound continue in secondary school because each holiday period some students will go on holiday in the city but I and my immediate elder brother will not go until after we must have done labourers for for like 2months to get money to keep ourselves for sometimes the next section.

After School cert the destiny was wounded again when I finished and my father said he can't train us beyond school cert.

Listen, your destiny can be wounded if you are not careful with the kind of friends you move with.

I came to Lagos immediately after School cert to continue with the wound like an orphan.

Declaration......Your children will not live like orphans in Jesus name.

The wound continue when I joined NEPA in 1984 as a canteen cleaner with grade level 01.

Hello, where you started may not really be the issue but where you end metters.

I started evening class and sat for GCE and passed and with that I was redesignated to clerical officer personnel.

God continue to heal the wound when I started writing ICAN exams, I started with ATS I&II.

The wound wanted to remain when I passed 4 subjects out of 5 subjects and I was to rewrite the whole 5 because I had double stars.

Declaration: I decree and I declared every power that want wounds to remain in your life and destiny shall be wasted

I wrote the five subjects again and I passed it, I wrote part two I passed it.

The healing became significant because ICAN ATS I &II then was equivalent to OND accounting in any Polytechnic in Nigeria.

With the certificate, I was redesignated to executive officer(iv) that is grade level 06 I was on that level for two three years.

After which I got married and the wound reappeared because there was delay for six years during which there was even physical wound in the fifth year of looking for the fruit of the womb.

I went for 7 days prayer on the 8th day as I was coming back, I had flat tyr, after I changed to extral thread I bent down to carry the licked tyre to put it in the boot, I heard a sound at my back.

Those of you waiting on the Lord for the fruit of the womb run outside here.
