TODAY'S DEVOTION

Ephesians 5:21

"Subject yourselves to one another in the fear of Christ."

When teaching on submission, many preachers immediately focus on the command given to wives in verse 22. As a result, we fail to recognize that the wife's submission is just one link in a long chain of command.

Because of our fallen nature, authority must exist in relationships.
