Ephesians 4:20-24 "But you did not learn Christ in this way, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, that, in reference to your former way of life, you are to rid yourselves of the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, and that you are to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and to put on the new [self, which [in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth."

In our last few studies, we have seen the contrast between the believer and the unbeliever. We are new creatures in Christ and our behavior must change. In order to to defeat sin and produce righteousness, God has given a new nature to enable us to please Him.

The believer is different from the unsaved person in that he has two natures. We are born with a fallen nature which we inherited from the first man, Adam. His disobedience introduced a lethal virus into the human race called sin. When we believe in Christ, we receive a new nature with the power to resist the sin nature. We retain the ability to sin, but we now also have the ability to please God.




