DON'T BE AFRAID, STAND FIRM. FIRST THREE DAYS - DAY 1

Text: Exodus 14:13-14

[13] And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever.

[14] The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace."

What does it mean to stand firm?

Exodus 14:13 is a powerful statement of faith and assurance from Moses to the Israelites.

The Israelites stand trapped between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's advancing army, Moses speaks to the people, telling them not to be afraid. He encourages them to stand firm and trust that God will deliver them.

In other words, God wants us to "stand still," and see or keep our eyes on Jesus. When we stop trying to solve the crisis using our own wisdom and strength, and turn to the Lord, He will "part the Red Sea" or make a way where there is none. He will fight our battles for us!

We are to stand firm in the faith. This means we are not wavering, stumbling, or easily moved. Our feet are planted on a foundation that can hold us.
