Text: Psalm 112:6-8

"6. Surely he will never be shaken; The righteous will be in everlasting remembrance.

7 He will not be afraid of evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. 8 His heart is established; He will not be afraid, Until he sees his desire upon his enemies." NKJV

They are confident and fearless. What a promise to claim! Are you ready to claim that in a time like this. Wouldn't you like to live your life like that? - Fear free life, You can! How? In another Psalm 118:6-7 the Bible says: "The LORD is for me, so I will have no fear. What can mere people do to me? Yes, the LORD is for me; He will help me." (NLT)

This is a disposition of faith, a confidence in God's unconditional love for you and I. What do you put your confidence in? Pilots put their confidence in their planes. Commuters place their confidence in trains, cars or buses. Each day, we must put our confidence in something or someone. If you are willing to trust a plane or a car to get you to your destination, are you willing to trust God to guide you here on earth and to your eternal destination? When you get into a plane, how much effort do you exercise to fly? None! Even in the plane we belief that is the only safe means of transportation in Nigeria now, it would look really funny if you begin flapping your arms in it.
