What does Christ our firm foundation means and how it impacts our lives?

Why Is It So Important to Have a Firm Foundation?

The Christian life is also built upon a foundation, and that foundation is Christ. We read:

1 Corinthians 3:11 "For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ"

Jesus is the firm foundation we can stand on in both the good and bad times.

Text: Matthew 7:24-27 NKJV

"Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall".

Sometimes our lives need to be rebuilt.

It's easy to become distracted by everything we have to do. And it's easy to run off the path God has for us.

We keep going and going until one day we realize we've neglected our relationship with Jesus and somehow we've built our spiritual house on sand and not on the rock.

That is why we have to rebuild our house from time to time, (myself included).

So how can we rebuild our home on the rock instead of sand?

As a Christian, if any situation or circumstance make you to compromise your faith, you era not matured and Christ is not your firm foundation.
