What is self-control?

Self-control is the ability to regulate one's emotions, thoughts, and behavior in the face of temptations and impulses.

As an executive function, it is a cognitive process that is necessary for regulating one's behavior in order to achieve specific goals.

Self-control is the ability to control our feelings, emotions, and reactions. Many people struggle with self-control.

For example, we need self-control when it comes to: staying off social media while at work,

sticking to a budget, and

regulating our sugar intake.

Self-control relates to chastity(The quality of being chaste: the state of abstaining from any sexual activity considered immoral; avoidance of sexual sins) and sobriety(A state of moderation or seriousness.

Modesty in color or style.

Soundness of judgement.) Particularly moderation in eating and drinking.

Self-control ἐγκράτεια (egkrateia) is the ability to control one's body and its sensual appetites and desires – physically and mentally through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Biblical self-control:

Self-control helps us to resist temptation and avoid conforming to the things of this world.

It guides our decisions, and it correlates with how we show the other fruits in our lives. For example, forbearance, or patience, requires self-control.

Biblical Self-control is the opposite of the works of the flesh that indulge selfish desires.

As Galatians 5:16 says "So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

Improving self-control and building good habits is much easier said than done, and it takes a lot of physical and mental discipline to better yourself.

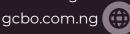
Here are five ways to help improve self-control and build good habits:

Monitoring helps us become experts on our own behavior, and it makes habits less difficult to govern and change.

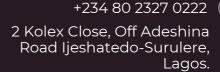
3. Learn How To Manage Stress
